


## ABOUT DAVANGERE

## ABOUT PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

RAGGING INSIDE OR OUTSIDE THE HOSTEL OR CAMPUS IS BANNED BY THE GOVERNMENT OF INDIA. ANYBODY, FOUND INDULGED IN RAGGING IN ANY FORM, WILL BE SUMMARILY EXPELLED FROM THE INSTITUTE.

### WHAT CONSTITUTES RAGGING?

Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts.

1. Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating, or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
2. Indulging in rowdy or indiscipline activity by any student or students which causes or is likely to cause annoyance, handship, physical, or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
3. Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame or torment or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
4. Any act of a senior student that prevents, disrupts, or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or freshers.
5. Exploiting the services of freshers or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
6. Any act of financial extortion of forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student.
7. Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it, sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping, forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
8. Any act of abuse by spoken words, sms, WhatsApp, e-mails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfort to freshers or any other student.
9. Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of freshers or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

### ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING

The institution shall punish a student to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments namely:

1. Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
2. Withholding / withdrawing scholarship / fellowship and other benefits.
3. Debarring from appearing in any test / examination or other evaluation process, withholding results.
4. Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festivals, etc.
5. Suspension / expulsion from the hostel.
6. Cancellation of admission.
7. Rustication from the institution for a period ranging from one to four years.
8. Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.



## ABOUT DIPLOMA IN PHARMACY

The D. Pharmacy Course offered by the institution is recognized by Pharmacy Council of India and Government of Karnataka.

- Duration** : 2 Years
- Eligibility for Admission** : Candidates should have passed Second year PUC (10 + 2 class or any equivalent examination) with PCM, PCB, PCMCs, or PCMB combination.
- Examination** : There shall be three sessional examinations conducted for both theory and practicals by the college for 20 marks during each academic year. The average marks of best two examinations for theory and practicals shall be computed separately. Board of Examining Authority, Bangalore shall conduct Final Examination for theory and practicals for 80 marks.
- Practical Training** : After passing Second Year D. Pharmacy Examination, the student shall undergo compulsory practical training of 500 Hours over a period of 3 months at an approved Hospital / Pharmacy.
- Results** : Student shall secure a minimum of 40% marks to pass, 50% marks for second class and 60% marks for first class.

## ABOUT S.S. HOSPITAL

The hospital is spread over a sprawling area of 170 acres of land, covered and surrounded with lush greenery, situated on Bangalore-Pune Road (NH-4). It is focusing on providing students with an environment that helps learning and imbibing positive value system. The hospital has requisite infrastructure and facility to adequately cater the health needs of the society. It's a 1000 bed strength capacity, tertiary care teaching hospital with advanced facilities and full-fledged individual departments. The hospital is considered as stage 4 referral hospital and a Central Regional Hospital. The department located at the hospital is placed adjacent to the wards for easy access to the doctors and patients and also has a very good professional backup involving dedicated staff, who train, guide, and mentor the students to effectively deliver clinical pharmacy services in the hospital.

**The Department of Pharmacy Practice is involved in various activities.**

- Drug Information Services
- Patient Counseling
- Adverse Drug Reactions Reporting
- Drug / Drug Interactions Reporting
- Drug Dosage Adjustments
- Developing Formulary

The department has good infrastructure viz., classrooms, seminar hall (equipped with LCD projectors), DIC (Drug Information Centre), well advanced library, etc., for providing drug information. A sophisticated, advanced, and updated Software "Micromedix" version 2 is used.



## ABOUT DOCTOR OF PHARMACY

The Pharm. D. course offered by the institution is recognized by Pharmacy Council of India & Government of Karnataka and affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka.

**Duration :** 6 Years course consisting of two phases. The Phase-I includes 5 academic years and The Phase - II includes one year internship program.

**Eligibility for Admission :** Candidates should have passed two years PUC examination of Karnataka PU Board or an equivalent examination of any other approved Board or University established by law in India with English as one of the subjects & Physics and Chemistry as compulsory subjects along with one of the following subjects; Mathematics or Biology or PCMB. Minimum Eligibility should be based on the aggregate marks of PCM or PCB. The candidates shall have passed subjects English, Physics, Chemistry & Biology / Mathematics individually also.

**Examination :** There shall be three sessional examinations conducted for both theory & practicals by the college for 30 marks. The average marks of best two examinations for theory & practicals shall be computed separately. University shall conduct final examination for theory & practical for 70 marks. The average marks and marks scored in the final examination will be combined to declare the results.

**Results :** Student shall secure a minimum of 50% marks to pass (which is also a second class), 60% marks for first class, and 75% marks for distinction.



## ABOUT BACHELOR OF PHARMACY

The B. Pharmacy Course offered by the institution is recognized by Pharmacy Council of India and Government of Karnataka, and affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka.

**Duration :** 4 Years (8 Semesters)

**Eligibility for Admission :** Candidates should have passed Second Year PUC ( 10 + 2 class or any equivalent examination) with minimum 40% marks in any combination comprising of PCM or PCB or PCMB or PCCs or PCE or PCIs or PCBt.

In case of students belonging to SC/ST or category-I, the minimum percentage of marks for admission to B. Pharmacy course shall be not less than 35% in PUC or an equivalent examination of any other approved Board or University in any combination mentioned above.

Candidates who have passed D. Pharmacy course are eligible to third semester B. Pharmacy course directly. Such students shall have to study Mathematics, Computer Science, Biology Communication Skills, Computer Applications in Pharmacy, and Environmental sciences in addition to the II B. Pharmacy subjects.

**Examination :** There shall be two sessional examinations conducted for both theory and practicals by the college for 25 marks and 15 marks, respectively. The average marks of two examinations for theory and practicals shall be computed separately. University shall conduct Final Examination for theory and practical for 75 marks and 35 marks, respectively. The average marks of sessional examinations and marks scored in the final examination will be considered to declare the results.

**Results :** Student shall secure a minimum CGPA of 5.00 to 5.99 to pass, CGPA of 6.00 to 7.49 for first class, and CGPA of 7.50 and above for first class with distinction.

## ABOUT MASTER OF PHARMACY

The M. Pharmacy Courses offered by the institution are recognized by Pharmacy Council of India, approved by Government of Karnataka, and affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka.

**Duration** : 2 Years (4 Semesters)

**Specialization** : Industrial Pharmacy  
Pharmacology

**Eligibility for Admission** : Candidates should have passed B. Pharmacy degree conducted by any Indian University or equivalent examination conducted by any recognized Foreign University with minimum 55% marks (aggregate of four years)

**Examination** : In first and second semesters, there shall be two sessional examinations for theory of 25 marks (including 10 marks of continuous mode) and two practical examinations for 50 marks conducted by the college. University shall conduct Final Examination separately for theory (75 marks) and practicals (100 marks). The average marks scored in the sessional examinations will be combined with the marks scored in the final examination to declare the results.

**Dissertation** : A student shall undergo Dissertation (Research Work) during third and fourth semesters of M. Pharmacy under the guidance of University Recognized Teachers.

**Results** : Student shall secure a minimum CGPA of 5.00 to 5.99 to pass, CGPA of 6.00 to 7.49 for first class, and CGPA of 7.50 and above for first class with distinction.
